Literacy

The Iron Man by Ted Hughes and Monster Slayer by Brian Patten. We will use the texts to incorporate learning on newspaper reports, persuasive writing, character descriptions and inference skills.

Spelling rules will focus on prefixes and suffixes and will focus on homophones.

Grammar - Possessive apostrophes, fronted adverbials, using verb forms accurately and prepositions.

Physical Education

We will focus on dynamic balance. We will also understand ways to judge performance and identify specific parts of a performance we can work on.

We are Musicians - We will use one or more programs to edit, create and develop a musical composition.
