IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING

The following groups of children bring additional funding allocations of up to £1,300 into school to support their learning:

- Children eligible for Free School Meals
- Children in care
- Children who have a parent in the Armed Forces
- Children adopted from care
- Children under a Special Guardianship Order

This additional funding is very important to our school. We use it to purchase vital resources, to aid teaching and provide extracurricular activities and trips.

Please let school know if your child falls into any of these categories so that we can update our records and apply for this additional funding. All information you provide remains completely confidential.

Your child is eligible for Free School Meals if parents/carers are in receipt of any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Job Seeker's Allowance (income based)
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, and have an annual income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs)
- Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit
- Support payments under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Working Tax Credit Run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if your annual net earned income does not exceed £7,400.

If you think you qualify just complete the attached form and return it either to the school office or direct to the Benefits Assessment Unit.
