Year 4 Summer 2 Curriculum Overview



Literacy

Bill's New Frock and Varjak Paw. We will use the texts to incorporate learning on character description, inference skills, comprehension and writing for a variety of purposes.

Spelling will focus on revision of spelling rules and jumping orange words.

Grammar - we will revise grammar objectives covered through the year.

Maths

Position and direction - co-ordinates and translations.

Properties of shapes - identify and compare acute and obtuse angles.

Decimals including money.

Converting measures.

We will continue to practise our times tables and corresponding division facts.

Religious Education

What kind of world did Jesus want? - We will learn about the story of the life and teaching of Jesus. We will also make clear links between the calling of the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'.

Music

Blackbird - This unit is focused around one song: Blackbird by The Beatles - a song about civil rights.

Physical Education

Health and fitness - We will practise events for Sports Day and take part in a variety of athletic events.

Science

Sound - We will carry out sound investigations and recognise that sound needs a medium to travel through.

French

Vive le Sport - We will be given the opportunity to talk about sports and healthy and unhealthy eating habits.

DT

Electronic Games - Using our prior knowledge of circuits, we will make playable games that make sounds.

History

We will be doing a locality study. We will study the change in landscapes and landmarks over time.
