

St. Andrew's CE (VA) Junior School Year 3 Summer 2 Curriculum Overview



Literacy

This half term we will be finishing the text 'Ice Palace' and using the work we have done in grammar to improve our writing. We will then read the text 'Gorilla' by Anthony Browne and write a non-chronological report about Gorillas.

We will continue to use our 'Read Write Inc' spelling scheme to look at the year 3 spelling rules.

Physical Education

This half term the children will be working with Premier Coaching focussing on athletics and we will also be preparing for our sports day.

PSHE

We will be working on what our rights and responsibilities are. Mrs Roberts will be teaching this session.

<u>ICT</u>

We will be learning basic ICT skills using Microsoft Publisher and creating a fact file. We will learn how to copy and paste, insert tables and images.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focussing on the properties of 2D and 3D shapes as well as angles, lines and aspects of measure.

As we have done all year we will continue to work on the times table and division facts for the three, four, six and eight times tables.

We will revisit how to use column and subtraction using digits up to 1000.

We will continue to use Mathletics and TT Rockstars to help our learning in lessons.

<u>History</u>

We will continue to study what life was like in the Roman times. We will be preparing a class assembly on this topic.

Science

We will be revisiting the topic 'animals including humans' which will link to our trip to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park.

Religious Education

This half term we will study 'How are different religious views expressed through art?' We will look at hoe dance, music and poetry express different feelings.

Our Christian Value this half term is Koinonia. We will look at working together as one.

Geography

We will continue to study Great Britain, learning more about the country we live in and learning more map skills.

<u>French</u>

In the final half term we will continue to look at greetings and basic conversational questions.
