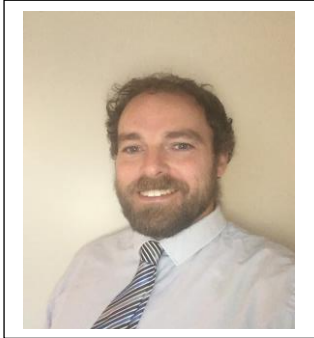


Class Canada

Your teacher is Mr Lyons.

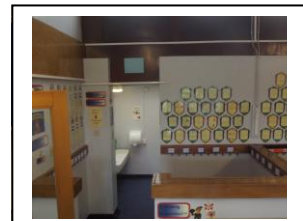
