Your teacher will be Miss Barker.



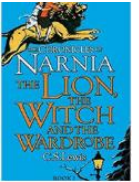
Hi Everyone!

You will come in through the year 6 door (above). You will line up at the right hand side and Class USA will line up at the left.

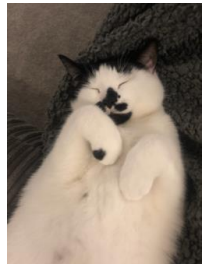
You will see the toilets as soon as you walk through the door.
