## Headteacher's Message

As you know, we always put the children at the heart of our decision-making. In these strange times, we are guided by advice from Public Health Calderdale. Going forward, there may be times when staff have to isolate due to Track and Trace. In a case like this, the children would be safe to remain in school. We always endeavour to maintain consistency for our children and where possible, if a teacher is not here, we will, **where we can**, use other school staff (Higher Level Teaching Assistants) to teach the children. The benefits to this are that they know the children and the school and can provide consistency.

A reminder to **have your childcare plans in place**. If we have to close a bubble (year group) we will have very little notice before we have to send children home for 14 days to isolate.

**Thank you** for all your support. Your positive comments mean a lot to us and help us in these challenging times. You are integral to our success and by following the COVID rules we continue to keep ourselves and each other safe. I am proud to be part of our community.
