Our topic for this half term will be forces and magnets. The children will investigate forces. They will also learn about how magnets attract and repel, identify poles and group magnetic materials. They will conduct experiments and begin to plan their own investigations. PUPILS WILL KNOW: How to compare how things move	This half-term, our topic will be Continents and Climate Change. We will begin by recapping the continents and learning how to use a globe and an atlas. The children will then explore the causes and impact of climate change before looking at ways to reduce it. They will then write their own climate change pledge. PUPILS WILL KNOW:	In PSHE, the children will be thinking about friendship. They will learn about building good relationships and explain why this is important. They will also discuss that sometimes we can experience difficult or hard times with friends. The children will begin by learning the phonics sounds for French to help them pronounce words correctly.
