We will be learning about electricity. PUPILS WILL KNOW: how to make a simple series circuit and identify why a simple circuit will or will not work. They will be able to identify insulators and conductors.	We will be learning about Brazil and South America. PUPILS WILL KNOW: what type of climate is in Brazil and will learn about some notable landmarks eg Christ the Redeemer and the Amazon. They will know why people choose to come to Brazil and South America and will know about how physical and human features can affect the locality positively and negatively.	We will be looking at Dreams and Goals PUPILS WILL KNOW: How to tell others about their hopes and dreams and know what to do in the face of adversity. They will also know how to create new dreams and think about steps to achieve their goals.	We will be learning a new rap about bullying and performing it. PUPILS WILL KNOW: All about rhythm and keeping time while performing. They will have opportunities to compose and perform.	We will be learning about colour theory and painting skills. PUPILS WILL KNOW: How to mix paints to make different colours. They will also know how to use water colours to create lighter and darker tones. They will discuss the work of a local artist and how they use water colours to great effect.
