Online Admissions Secondary School 2023





This leaflet provides some information regarding applying for your child's secondary school place for September 2023. However, please consider carefully all the information available on the website www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions before submitting your online application. Your preferred schools (up to 5) must be submitted on your online application between 21 June 2022 and 31 October 2022. An automated acknowledgement of your application will be sent by email.

If you have no internet access, facilities are available at Calderdale Libraries. Your child's current primary school may also offer internet access.

Important Information

- Register and apply online by 31 October 2022
- Ensure the information you provide is accurate including sibling details and permanent home address. A school place may be withdrawn if a false address is provided.
- Performance tables can be accessed via www.calderdale.gov.uk/schools
- Ofsted reports and other school information can be found on the school's website.

What happens next

1 March 2023 -National Offer Day

Calderdale Council will notify Calderdale residents of the school place offered by email. Non-Calderdale residents will receive their offer from their home local authority.

1 to 15 March 2023 -Reallocation and Appeal requests

You can request that your child's name is added to a waiting list for any school which may have places become available after 1 March. Parents will be given the right of appeal for any school where a place has been refused. Further information regarding this process is available at www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions. Parents will be notified of the outcome of their reallocation request, in writing, by 29 March 2023.

QI

How and when do I apply for a school place?

Al

An online application will need to be submitted between 21 June and 31 October 2022. Please visit www.calderdale.gov.uk/admissions

Q2

My child currently attends Calder Primary School/The Halifax Academy, do I need to complete an application if my child wishes to remain at the school?

A2

You do NOT need to complete an application if your child currently attends one of Calderdale's through-schools (ie Calder Primary School or The Halifax Academy, Primary Provision) and you would just like them to move into the Secondary Phase of the school. However, if you would like your child to be considered for any other Secondary School, you will need to submit an application.

Q3

Do I need to complete any additional forms other than the online application?

A3

For your child to be able to sit the admissions test for the grammar schools or the fair banding assessment for Trinity Academy Halifax or Trinity Academy Grammar, you will need to complete a registration form which is available on the schools' websites. You must register for the admissions test for the grammar schools by the 1 July 2022.

Q4

In what order should I state my preferred schools?

A4

Preference your schools in the order you would like them allocated. The highest preference will be met if a child is eligible for a place at more than one school. All preferences are considered equally.

Q6

How will I be notified of my child's allocated school?

A6

If you have requested your offer by email, you will receive an email from cyps.admissions on 1 March 2023. If an email notification was not requested, an offer letter will be sent directly to your home address or passed to your child via the current primary school.

Q5

If I only preference one school, will my child be offered a place at that school?

A5

Not necessarily. If the authority is unable to meet your preference(s) a place will be allocated at the closest school to the family home with a vacancy. Parents are strongly recommended to make use of the 5 preferences available. Non-Calderdale residents will have a school place allocated by their home local authority.
