

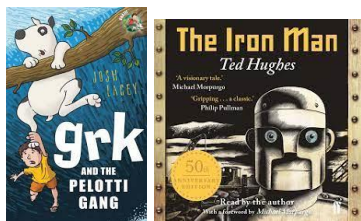

Year 4 SPRING 1 Curriculum Overview 2022-23

Key learning this half term

Literacy	Maths	Religious Education
<p>This half term we will be reading Grk and the Pelotti Gang by Joshua Lacey and The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We will produce newspaper stories, character descriptions, story writing and recounts. This book will explore aspects of Brazil and South America, which will give children opportunities to marry together learning from Geography. This half term we will complete a study on South America and Brazil. Our grammar focus will be on fronted adverbials, correct tense in sentences, inverted commas and adverbs.</p>	<p>We will be working out the length and perimeter of 2D shapes and regular polygons and finding equivalent lengths using kilometres and metres. We will also be doing work on tenths and hundredths as decimals including dividing numbers by ten and one hundred.</p> <p>We will also work on fractions, including unit and non-unit fractions. We will count in tenths, hundredths find equivalent fractions, convert improper and proper fractions and work with fractions greater than 1.</p> <p>We will practise our times tables and corresponding division facts. We will have a weekly times table focus. Times table are in integral part of learning in Year 4. We will be completing the National Multiplication Table Checker in the Summer term. Please practise times tables regularly at home.</p>	<p>We will be asking the question, 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We will discuss how Jesus challenged everyone to live through Christian beliefs. We will also look at how Christians try to be more like Jesus and how they try to put his teachings and examples into practice in lots of ways.</p> <p>Pupils will know that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Incarnation is good news for people.• Gospel means good news.<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The gospels are where we can learn about the life and teachings of Jesus.• The disciples were 12 men that Jesus called to be his followers.

They will also know how to create new dreams and think about steps to achieve their goals.</p>	<p>We will be looking at how music improves our world.</p> <p>PUPILS WILL KNOW : All about rhythm and keeping time while performing. They will have opportunities to compose and perform. They will look at the positive impact music has on culture and well being.</p>	<p>We will be learning about colour theory and painting skills.</p> <p>PUPILS WILL KNOW: How to mix paints to make different colours. They will also know how to use water colours to create lighter and darker tones. They will discuss the work of a local artist and how they use water colours to great effect.</p>
