Year 6 Summer 1 Curriculum Overview

Maths

Key learning this half term

Literacy

We will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. We will focus on reading objectives but also find inspiration for some great writing activities including a balanced argument and a message in a bottle.





We will also look at how to write a variety of text types including, suspense

stories, prequels, sequels, diary entries and letters using prompts from short films. Our grammar focus will be on the different tenses, colons and semi-colons, passive and active voice and the subjunctive form. Spelling will be a revision of the spelling rules taught over Years 5 and 6 to prepare for KS2 SATs.

We will be working through the White Rose Maths Hub scheme of learning for the Summer term, which includes: geometry: properties of shape, statistics, problem solving and investigations.

We will learn how to measure angles using a protractor and how to calculate angles both within triangles and quadrilaterals.

We will be continuing to complete a weekly arithmetic to consolidate our mental strategies and formal written methods for the four operations.

We will also be continuing to complete our CGP 10-minute test booklets which consolidate our reasoning skills.

PUPILS WILL DISCUSS AND LEARN:


- Different reasons of why people do or do not believe in God.
- Make clear connections between what people believe about God and the impact of this belief on how they live.
- Give evidence and examples to show how Christians sometimes disagree about what God is like (e.g. some differences in interpreting Genesis).
- Reflect on and articulate some ways in which believing in God is valuable in the lives of believers, and ways it can be challenging
- Make connections between belief and behaviour in their own lives

We will be learning about mountains and volcanoes. Using atlases, we will identify physical features of countries around the world including mountain range, volcanoes and earthquake zones. We will look at the UK and identify where there are mountains and why there are no active volcanoes or series earthquakes.

PUPILS WILL KNOW THAT:

- Tectonic plates determine where earthquakes occur
- How mountains and volcanoes are formed
- Volcanoes erupt when magma rises to the surface
- How to use an atlas to locate areas of mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes.
