We have other reasons to celebrate too! We have achieved some of the best results we have ever achieved in our Key Stage 2 assessments (SATs). Year 6 pupils have worked incredibly hard throughout their time at St. Andrew's to achieve outcomes which are substantially above National Average and Calderdale's results (LA). The table below shows the percentage of pupils who have achieved the Age Related Expectation (or above) in Key Stage 2. Well done to everyone involved. What an achievement!
