



St. Andrew's CE (VA) Junior School Year 4 SPRING 1 Curriculum Overview 2024-2025

Key learning this half term:

Maths	Religious Education
We will be exploring correct written methods for multiplying two digit and three digit numbers with a one digit number. We will practise our times tables and corresponding division facts. We will have a weekly times table focus. Times table are in integral part of learning in Year 4. We will be completing the National Multiplication Table Checker in the Summer term. Please practise times tables regularly at home. Each child has a 'heat map' in their planner that they need to use to inform them which times tables they need to practise. Our focus will be on the 7, 9, 6 and 12 times tables.	In RE this half term, we will be asking the question 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?' Pupils will learn to: Identify some Hindu deities and describe Hindu beliefs about God (e.g. Brahman, trimurti) Make links between Hindu beliefs and the aims of life (e.g. karma). Describe how Hindus show their faith within their families in Britain today (e.g. home puja) Describe how Hindus show their faith within their faith communities in
We will also be learning about how to calculate the length and perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and regular polygons.	Britain today (e.g. arti and bhajans at the mandir; Diwali), indicating some differences in how Hindus show their faith.
