Our science focus for this half term will be animals, including humans. We will group animals according to where they live and what they eat. We will learn about UK rivers and mountains by looking at the longest river and the tallest mountain and how we can find these features in an atlas. We will learn how to measure the temperature and we will track the temperature over the lessons and see how it changes. PUPILS WILL KNOW THAT: The River Severn is the longest river in the UK. Ben Nevis is the highest mountain in the UK. Thermometers record temperature in Celsius.	In PSHE we will look at dreams and goals. We will be thinking about people who have faced challenges and achieved success. They will think about their hopes and ambitions for the future and learn strategies for dealing with challenging situations. PUPILS WILL KNOW: How they can succeed when things are challenging. We will look at how we record music and write it down and also how music can affect our mood.
