Hello my name is Madison Lord. I am in Class India in Year 6. As you all know my twin brother Ethan sadly died earlier this year.

Ethan spent a lot of time being cared for by Forget Me Not Children's Hospice and I have got lots of lovely memories of the time we spent with him in his final days. The hospice also provide me with sibling support sessions and I want other families to be able to have the same support and care me and my family have had but all this costs lots of money.

On **Thursday 5th June** we are going to try again to raise a significant amount by holding another Fun Day. The day will be non-uniform (**wear something purple**), and every child will take part in a sponsored obstacle course. The teachers also have some fun surprises up their sleeves

We would like every child to get as many sponsors as possible to help us raise as much money as we can.
