The fair will be held on Wednesday 11th June, where children will showcase their science boards in our school hall. Three winners will be chosen from the following categories:


- Year 3 and 4 winner

The three winners (and their adults) will be invited to show their work at The Ogden Trust Science Fair at Copley Primary School on 26th June 6pm-6.30pm. An overall winner will then be chosen from the 7 participating primary schools and will be awarded with the Oliver Smithies Trophy.

Children have been given the opportunity to get a planning sheet from their teachers. Please hand this in to your class teacher as soon as possible. Science boards will then be available for collection 23rd May (if you wish to purchase your own in a colour other than white, they are available at a reasonable price from The Range).
