

Voices Together - Further Information and Tickets

Tuesday 1st July 2025

6.30pm - 8.30pm, Victoria Theatre, Halifax

Our school are taking part in Voices Together 2025 on the above date and tickets for the concert are now on sale.

Organised by Calderdale Music, this singing event will involve around 1400 children over three nights joining together in song, meaning this year is even bigger and better than before! Everyone will perform four "Big Songs" together with a live band. Some schools will even sing their own song on stage!

Tickets

Family and friends of performers can buy tickets and watch from the circle and balcony. Tickets will be available to purchase online from Wednesday 30th April 2025.

Costs per tickets are as follows:

Adults - £13 plus £2.50 theatre support fee.

Over 60s and students - £12 plus £2.50 theatre support fee.

Under 16s - £11 plus £2.50 theatre support fee.

If for accessibility reasons you require access to seats in the stalls, please call the Victoria Theatre box office directly on 01422 351158. Please note that pupils will be performing from the stalls for half of the concert, then swapping on to the stage so there will be a lot of movement around the stalls area during the interval.
